MUSWELLBROOK With the lockdowns now being extended their impacts are now beginning to take their toll.

In our area we are seeing three levels of financial impact.

Minimal – Essential business and the businesses that support them.

Moderate – Those businesses that are closed to the public but continue to trade online via click and collect, or those that are doing takeaway and delivery. (reduction in income and just surviving)

Significant – Those that have no choice but to close their doors and who have no alternate method of servicing customers. (no income at all)

To assist struggling business owners and their families, the Chamber is initiating a 'Locals Supporting Locals' campaign. Care Packs will be put together from purchases of products and gift cards from those at level 2 (Moderate) for distribution to those at level 3 (Significant). By doing it this way, it is a multi-layered support campaign, assisting both those at the Moderate and Significant levels at the same time.

Although the 'Gift Packs' will not be life changing, they will provide a small financial relief to ease some of the pressures, but more importantly, they will provide a much needed morale boost to those doing it tough. With many trying to cope financially whilst in isolation, and with Fathers Day just around the corner, the Locals Supporting Locals campaign will send a message that their community has not forgotten them.

Mt Arthur Coal delivers 5000 tests to keep COVID-19 outside the gates.

Mt Arthur Coal celebrates a milestone this week with 5000 Rapid Antigen Tests being delivered at their site COVID-19 testing clinic.

With NSW in lockdown and COVID-19 cases seeding outside of Greater Sydney into the Hunter Region, Mt Arthur Coal moved quickly to implement site based COVID-19 testing. In a first for site based testing across the BHP coal assets the team stood up a walk in Rapid Antigen Testing clinic, with gate access blocks placed on employee and contractor profiles who reside in a Local Government Area with known COVID-19 community exposure.



The Rapid Antigen Test is much less invasive than the regular PCR testing and can return a negative COVID-19 result in under 15 minutes, allowing gate blocks to be lifted.

Since inception the clinic has seen an average of 400 employees and contractors who reside in an area with known COVID-19 exposure, tested daily.

If more exposure sites are identified this control can be scaled, with a drive through clinic setup and tested which would enable Rapid Antigen Testing of every Mt Arthur Coal employee prior to shift, if local exposure deemed this level of control necessary.

Due to Mt Arthur Coal's ability to rapidly implement high level controls including waste water sampling, contact tracing, Rapid Antigen Testing and PCR Testing onsite, the team have confidence that the site is safe to remain operational, even if workplace exposure to COVID-19 was to occur.

"I'm really proud of the team for the way they have stood up the COVID controls in just a matter of weeks," said Mt Arthur Coals General Manager, Adam Lancey.

"I can't thank the team enough for their work to stand up and comply with these testing controls to keep our people and their families safe," he said.

NSW 2021 Local Government Elections Update

Voting as a non-resident in a ward or council area for the NSW 2021 Local Government Elections - 4 December 2021

Did you know that you may be eligible to vote as a non-resident in a council area if you are:

- an owner of rateable land in the ward or council area
- an occupier or rate-paying lessee of rateable land in the ward or council area.

Non-residential rolls are prepared and certified by each council's general manager, and the NSW Electoral Commissioner must confirm that the voters listed are eligible for enrolment on the non-residential roll. However, individual applicants are responsible for checking that they are eligible for inclusion in the non-residential roll for a council. The NSW Electoral Commission recommends that you seek independent advice if you are unsure about whether you are eligible to apply.

Applications for inclusion on the non-residential roll of Muswellbrook Shire Council can be made by completing an application form on Council's website at www.muswellbrook.nsw.gov.au

Completed applications must be received by Council by 5:00pm, Monday 25 October 2021.

The Hunter Coal Festival has been postponed until next year due to concerns about the ongoing Covid-19 situation.

Organised by the Singleton Business Chamber, the festival was scheduled for October/November this year but will now be held in October 2022.

Confirmed venues and dates for the festival's major events in 2022 are:

Friday, October 21, 2022 - Careers and Innovation Expo, TAFE NSW Muswellbrook campus

Friday, October 28, 2022 - Mining Leaders Lunch, Singleton Civic Centre

Saturday, October 29, 2022 – Singleton Community Day, Singleton Showground

Singleton Business Chamber Sue Gilroy said the decision to postpone the festival again was difficult but necessary.

"We are sorry to have to postpone the events again but after much consultation with sponsors and other partners, we decided the safest course of action is to delay the festival events until the Covid situation is under better control," Ms Gilroy said.

"The current unpredictable Covid situation posed a very real risk to the events. Future snap lockdowns could have forced cancellation weeks or days before the events were to take place.

"Even before the current Hunter lockdown, Covid regulations in place would have also greatly limited the scope of festival events."

Organisers also opted to move the festival to October instead of early 2022 to give more time for Covid mitigation measures to be put in place to allow a bigger and better festival.

"Essentially, we decided it was better to be 'safe than sorry again'," Ms Gilroy said.

"Planning and organistion for the festival was well underway but all of the plans are transferrable to 2022," Ms Gilroy said. "And we will continue to work to make the 2022 festival bigger and better than ever."
