
All the candidates were invited to attend, with seven accepting. These included: Stuart Bonds (Independent).

the labour and skills shortage, plus the current housing shortage.



## **Judging for 2022 Business Awards now Completed**

Judging for the 2022 Muswellbrook Business Awards has been completed. This year saw a record number of entries across nine categories. A change to the format this year, will see some of the categories aligned with the Hunter Business Awards, which will mean the winners of those categories in the Muswellbrook Awards will automatically become finalist in the Hunter Business Awards.

The Muswellbrook Business Awards, staged by the Chamber are unique, where entries are judged on both their written submissions, and face-to face interviews, which are conducted at their place of business.

The face-to-face interviews are conducted over three days by three independent judges.

Despite the challenges of the last few years, it was clear when meeting with entrants, that all are keen to move on and put the difficulties of Covid-19 behind them. During the judging process, there were great signs of positive energy on display and an overwhelming sense of optimism.

The issue of staff and skills shortages was a common denominator mentioned to the judges as they met with each business. For many, it was the most pressing issue that they were currently faced with managing.

Through the written application, and face-to-face interviews, it provides an ideal opportunity for a business to take stock and reflect on what they have achieved over the last twelve months, and what their plans are for the next twelve months.

The three judges, who all score independently of each other, also provide their own written feedback to each of the entrants following the awards on what is believed could be improved upon.

The Business Awards culminate with a Gala Presentation Dinner that allows businesses to get together socially with their teams and celebrate their achievements.

We congratulate all the finalists in this year's awards and thank them for their support of the Chamber and the Business Awards.
